SELECTION OF MAHAMANA MALAVIYA RESEARCH AWARDEES : A screening committee of 5 persons under the chairmanship of the National President/his nominee will be constituted to screen the research papers.

The screening committee will comprise of a Vice chancellor (officiating or retired), two professors (one each of science and humanities) and two MMM members (as language experts for Hindi and English), nominated by the National President. This committee may further set the refined guidelines for the selection process, if necessary for clarity, depending on the number, nature and the quality of research papers. It will finally recommend the names of the awardees.

AWARD PRIZES : There will be Prizes in four categories:

First prize: Rs. 21,000

Second prize: Rs. 15,000

Third prize : Rs. 11,000

Consolation prizes : Rs. 4,000 each

(Number of Consolation prizes may vary with potential of the paper)

Along with these prizes, the awardees will be given a Certificate by the Mahamana Malaviya Mission.

SCREENING AND SELECTION PROCESS : The Screening Committee will review the submitted research papers in November and recommend the names of the awardees by the end of this month.

The prizes will be announced in the first week of December and presented on 25th December every year in a grand public function, attended by the persons of eminence from different walks of life, on the occasion of Malaviya Jayanti.
